## Kouga Wind Farm 80 MW

Eastern Cape

The Kouga Wind Farm can generate approximately 300 GWh of clean electrical energy per year, equivalent to the annual consumption needs of approximately 50 000 average households, while avoiding the emission of over 290 000 tonnes of  ${\rm CO}_2$  into the atmosphere annually. The local community is a significant shareholder in the project owning 26% of the wind farm.

## Gibson Bay Wind Farm 111 MW

Eastern Cape

In line with Red Cap's desire to ensure that communities are truly uplifted by their projects, the local community owns 40% of the Gibson Bay Wind Farm. The Gibson Bay Wind Farm can generate around 420 GWh per year, equivalent to the annual consumption needs of around 131000 South African households while avoiding the emission of over 383000 tonnes of  ${\rm CO_2}$  into the atmosphere each year.
